



Armenia, Colombia, April 28, 2024

Beloved Pastors and brethren,

I greet you in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. 1 Timothy 1:12 I thank him that strengthened me, Jesus Christ our Lord, because he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry.

By the grace of God on February 1st we moved to Armenia, Colombia, it was not easy because we had many complications to get a house for rent because the costs

are very high but thanks to the Lord we made it.

On February 3rd in the afternoon there was a terrible downpour but thanks to the Lord and the downpour we realized that the roof of the house was totally rotten, and all night water came in everywhere we had great work filling buckets and throwing them away all night. Thank the Lord none of the moving boxes or furniture were damaged.

I spoke to the owner of the house who lives in London England and he said he would replace the entire roof and put a new one on. Thank the Lord we now have a new roof.

It has not been easy because starting from scratch in a place without knowing anyone is not easy but we thank the Lord that has allowed us to adapt to the new city, the customs and the people.

We have also been evangelizing and fruit of this work we were able to gather 17 people in our house and 8 of them accepted the Lord. We are already initiating direct discipleship with them.

We have also been visiting Uriel and his wife Indeli who also received the Lord in their home and we will also start discipleship with them.

On April 7th we were in Mexico because a young lady from the San Fernando church in Bogota married a young man from the Texcoco church in Mexico, and they asked me to officiate the wedding.

We also traveled to Panama to the Philadelphia Baptist church in Colon, a church that by the grace of God the Lord allowed me to start in 1995 since it is currently without a Pastor and is being managed with some of its leaders whom I am helping; I am also discipling via Zoom some brothers there and baptized 3 new members, while God raises a new Pastor there. We also had a seminar for Gentlemen and my wife one with the ladies and we did another seminar for Couples because the devil is bent on destroying homes.

We returned to Colombia for the civil marriage of my daughter Aby with Andres Felipe a young man from the congregation of Bogota if the Lord allows us on July 27 we will have the wedding in the church. We give glory to God for all this.

We ask your prayers for the following requests:

1) We need to find a place to rent to install the printing press to print the bible correspondence courses since the house where we live is very small and we don't have the space.



2) We ask the Lord to supply us with the money to buy a washer and dryer since we don't have one and it is a little difficult for my wife.

3) We also need to rent a small moving truck to move everything concerning the christian educational institute already printed material and printing machines from Bogota to here in Armenia; once we find an economical place to rent so we can start the reproduction and distribution of biblical material (booklets, bible studies) in this city and surrounding towns.

4) We need to buy if the Lord permits an electric plant to project evangelistic films in towns and places of difficult access where there is no electricity.

5) We also need to buy a Video Beam if the Lord allows it since the one we had was left in the congregation in Bogota for its use.

6) Please help us to pray for our security because with the communist government that we have in Colombia the insecurity has increased greatly.

7) Please pray for the 8 people that we won for Christ so that satan will not gain any advantage and for Uriel and his wife Indeli.

8) Please pray that the Lord will supply all that is needed for our daughter Aby's wedding on July 27th.

From my heart I thank you for your love, your continued prayers and support for us and the ministry in which it has pleased the Lord to place us in His service.
